

Non-Profit Housing Agency Applauds Planning Commission’s Decision to Suggest Cobbs Hill Village Enhancements

ROCHESTER, N.Y., January 12, 2018 – Rochester Management President and CEO Peggy Hill issued the following statement today:

“We applaud the Rochester Planning Commission’s decision on Thursday to provide specific and constructive suggestions for enhancing the modernization plan for Cobbs Hill Village.

“The Planning Commission stated its intent to provide formal, written direction around its suggestions. Our nonprofit agency intends to work through those specific and constructive suggestions to ensure our modernized affordable senior housing community aligns with the Commission’s vision for this project and for this area of Rochester.

“We look forward to continuing to work closely with the City to create a modernized Cobbs Hill Village that will allow our seniors to age in place and with dignity, regardless of their race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, economic resources, or disability.”

Cobbs Hill Village has been governed by New York State Mitchell Lama program guidelines for low-to-middle income housing since 1957. A modernized complex would continue to comply with the very same guidelines and income mandates.
